A new approach to Project Management.

What are the benefits?

Participants will be able to:

- Increase efficiency of delivering change programmes against identified objectives.
- Manage projects following a structured lifecycle, from the conception through to the evaluation stage.
- Apply feasibility studies and risk assessments to the management of the project.
- Identify realistic requirements of resources
- Apply performance measuring and monitoring, to evaluate progress .
- Show progress against plan, at each of the gateways of the lifecycle, using project management software where appropriate.
- Transfer learning into their working practices.
- Identify how lean techniques, implemented in a sustainable way can benefit teams and organisations.

How much does it cost?

With 60% funding available for eligible companies within the Yorkshire and Humber for a limited time, the cost per delegate has been reduced from £720.00 to **£255.99.*** (plus VAT)

Who should attend?

Designed for those either responsible for, or involved in, the management and delivery of change & lean programmes.

How is the learning delivered?

A hands on, activity based workshop, which goes against the trend of prepared slides and tutor lecturing.

Participants consider their own experience and discuss with others, to gain insight into other industries and organisations, to deliver richness and depth to their learning experience.
